### **NEW Automatic External Defibrillator**

Gifford Community Council supports several machines (AED or Defibs). The sites are:

Both these AEDs are accessible 24 hours a day and do not need a PIN to open. Also:

- Yester school, during school hours
- Gifford golf club: inside the clubhouse
