

Report for 12th April:

- Nationally:
 - 88% of over 80s have had their 2nd dose
 - 653,299 (85%) people in Group 6 have had their 1st dose of a Covid Vaccine, and 9% their 2nd dose. This Group is now completed for 1st dose i.e. well-protected.
 - Over 16: 58% had 1st dose and 12% 2nd

- Lothian: a total of 50% people have had 1st dose, 379,544
 - and 9.5% had 2nd dose, 72,040 (NB Lothian has a higher than average younger population, hence figures for total vaccinations look lower)

- **East Lothian:** 60.5% have had 1st dose, 52,890 people,
 - 11.2% 9,798 had 2nd dose.

Nationally, working through Group 9, over 50s.

Locally: working through Group 9 over the last 2 weeks i.e. over 50s.

We assume that the next cohort will be those who have already had their 1st dose, and due for 2nd doses at about 12 weeks, i.e. over 70s. Groups 3 and 4.
